

Overview

Muktinath is a sacred pilgrimage site in the Mustang region of Nepal, which is a place that you must go there once in your lifetime. It is an important site for both Hindu and Buddhists. Muktinath temple lies approximately about 18 kms northeast of Jomsom at an altitude of (3749 M-12184 Ft), which is the main shrine, dedicated to Lord Vishnu. The Holy Lake in Muktinath, 108 water sprouts, and the temple itself are the subjects that keep you busy in worshipping, holy bath, and others. The route to Muktinath temple goes along the Kali Gandaki River, where the precious stone, Shaligrama can be found. Several options are available for the trip to Muktinath: by road, by flight via Jomsom, by trek via the Annapurna region, and by helicopter tour.

Itinerary Details

Day 01 : Kathmandu – Arrival

On arrival, meet our representative at the Kathmandu airport & transfer to hotel. Check-in at the hotel. O/N stay in Hotel.

Day 02 : Kathmandu- Sightseeing

After breakfast, move for city sightseeing Pashupatinath, (Hindu Temple) a majestic temple with golden roof and is considered as one of Nepal's most important Hindu pilgrimage centers, Boudhnath (Buddhist stupa), a colossal stupa which is one of the biggest in the world and serves as a center of Tibetan Buddhism, Swayambhunath (Monkey Temple) & Kathmandu durbar square. O/N stay in Hotel.

Day 03 : Kathmandu– Pokhara [210 Km – 7 Hours]

After breakfast, move to Pokhara via Manokamana Devi's temple Darsan (The Wish fulfilling Goddess). A place of remarkable landscape against the Annapurna Range. Check in at hotel. O/N stay in Hotel.

Day 04 : Pokhara – Jomsom by Jeep [150 Km – 10 Hours]

Early in the Morning breakfast then drive to Jomsom on the way enjoying in Kali Gandaki River and view of lots of Mountain Include Annapurna. O/N Hotel at Jomsom.

Day 05 : Jomsom – Muktinath Darsan - Pokhara.

Early Morning transfer to Muktinath by jeep puja & Darshan of lord Muktinath and Take a shower on 108 taps then drive back to Pokhara via Jomsom. O/N stay in Hotel.

Day 06 : Pokhara Sightseeing

After breakfast move for city tour International Mountain Museum, Seti River, Devi's fall, Gupteshowre Cave and Phewa Lake. Remaining of the day, free for own leisure for shopping around the lakeside with good bargains. O/N stay in Hotel.

Day 07 : Pokhara – Kathmandu [210 Km –6 Hours]

After breakfast, depart for Kathmandu. Check - in at the hotel in Kathmandu. O/N stay in Hotel.

Day 08 : Kathmandu – Departure

After breakfast day free for shopping till departure your time. Transfer to Kathmandu airport.
